Update to the Privacy Policy

You may be aware that we have been working very closely with CACI and Webber-Phillips over the last few years to make the most of Acorn and Origins software. The main drive has been to enable you to identify under-represented communities more effectively so you can target recruitment activity really effectively. The tools are designed to support you in ensuring that your database is representative of the local area from a social, economic, ethnicity and religious basis so all sections of your community have a voice.

Recent work with West Midlands Police has identified that the website terms and our privacy policy would benefit from an update to reflect this increasing aspect of the system. To be clear, we do not share any data with Acorn or Webber-Phillips but we use their data to compare with registered users to assist in identifying those gaps in your database.

We are grateful to the Information Management team and our contacts at West Midlands Police for reviewing the Privacy Policy and making the suitable amendments.

Could you please review the proposed updated Website Terms and Privacy Policy here (the amendments are shown in yellow) and let me know by Wednesday 1st December if you have any concerns or reasons why we should not update this global policy. If you are happy with this small amendment, you do not need to do anything.

As part of the update process and in line with our website terms and GDPR, we (VISAV) will send a notification to all users on the system by email (text and voice to those that do not have email) to notify them about the change. We intend to send this notification on 1st December.

VISAV will cover all message costs relating to this notification. This is simply part of the ongoing robust compliance. Please be assured that this update in no way compromises our core values regarding the absolute privacy of all data we store.

Acorn Data Contact

I am pleased to report that our working relationship with CACI who provide the Acorn Geo-Demographic and Wellbeing data is better than ever. We now host one of their superb datasets nationally which means we can onboard any force almost instantly (with Rhi's permission).
