The Importance of Effective Use of Information

(Its not just about what you've got it's what you do with it that matters)







Nail = Community information – Alone has a use but is not effective

Hammer = Targeted Activity Hammer & Nail
Put them together and it now becomes effective

Simple BUT Effective.....

- Identify Top Community Issues
- Send a targeted message to the interest group
- Monitor and respond to the replies
- Take Action
- Feedback the results



The house was found to have 500 plants with a rough street value of 60k.

Its scarey to think that houses within our communities are being converted into cannabis farms.


The people who normally engage in this kind of activity are usually connected to organized crime.




